**LDR 150 – Intro to Life Calling**  
**Course Syllabus 2010-2011**

LDR 150 is a required junior course for all MCS students (less Independent Studies). The outcomes, textbooks, and expectations of the course are set by Indiana Wesleyan University. Grading rubrics and grading scales are determined by the college.

Course Description:

LDR 150 is a three credit semester course designed to help students to determine God's calling on their lives. The course is based on the "Life Purpose Model" developed by Dr. Bill Millard of Indiana Wesleyan University. The model consists of three main components: Foundational Values, Unique Design, and Personal Mission. These components interact with one another synergistically to determine a person's life purpose. Within those components are elements that are subtopics of the main component. The entirety of the course comes from a biblical perspective and is biblically integrated. Examples of biblical insight are highlighted in each chapter of Explorer's Guide, the textbook for the course. Some examples of biblical integration are listed below:
