

Mansfield Christian Title 1 Program Parents Right-to-Know Policy – August 2017

It is a requirement of any school receiving funds under <u>Title 1</u> that parents be notified at the beginning of every school year that they may request information regarding the professional qualifications of their student's classroom teachers, and any paraprofessionals that will be working with their children, including at a minimum the following:

- Whether the Ohio Department of Education has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- Whether the Ohio Department of Education has decided that the teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- The Teacher's college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees or certifications, and, if so, the subject to which the degree applies.
- Whether any teachers or similar paraprofessionals provide services to the parent's child and, if so, their qualifications and the services they provide.

In addition, parents may request and a school shall provide to each parent the following:

- Information on the level of achievement of their child in each of the state academic assessments as required under by the Ohio Department of Education.
- Timely notice that their child has been assigned, or has been taught, for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who is not highly qualified.
