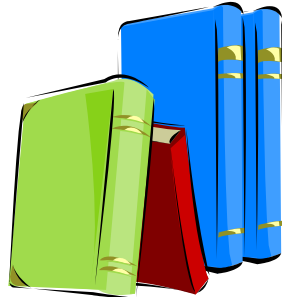

## How to Sell Used Books:

*Over the years, I have heard how difficult it is for some of you to attend on Saturdays because of soccer games and other weekend activities; therefore, we are going to have just a Friday night sale this year. Your items really need to be brought during the day on Friday, the day of the sale between 8:00 a.m.—3:00 p.m.*

*Thank you for your cooperation.*

- ◆ NO items will be accepted without being properly marked.
- ◆ Fill out a 3" X 5" INDEX CARD with Your Name, Price, Name of Book, Subject, and Grade Level for each book that you want to sell. Staple or tape the card to the outside of the book.
- ◆ Put YOUR address on the back of every card. Address labels work well for this.
- ◆ With pen, write your name, phone number, and cost of the book on the 1st page of the book in case the card gets lost.
- ◆ **Submit a list of all books you are bringing for us to sell; keep a copy for yourself. This is very important at pick-up time.**
- ◆ Rubber band sets securely together & mark as sets. (Book 1 of 2, 2 of 4)
- ◆ It is a tremendous help to us if you drop your books off May 11, the day of the sale, between the hours of 8:00 a.m.—3:00 p.m. I do realize, however, that many of you drive a distance, so you can bring them right before the sale, but we will ask that you help us in laying out your items if that is the case. You will not be permitted to shop early, but simply help us get your items sorted.
- ◆ Used books may be brought any time during the sale. However, most people look for their used materials within the first two hours of the Sale.
