ADMISSIONS POLICY

The mission of Mansfield Christian School is to “exist as an extension of the Christian home and church, to fulfill God’s commands to teach His words “diligently to our children” (Deuteronomy 6:5-7). Our foundation rests upon acknowledging Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and the Bible as the Word of God – the final authority in truth and practice (II Timothy 2:15). We strive to assist each student to grow in excellence spiritually, academically, socially, and physically (Luke 2:52). Through the Godly ministry and example of teachers, administrators, board members, and staff (Titus 1:15-16). We serve with the cooperation of parents who support us through their prayers and involvement in the activities of Mansfield Christian School (Ephesians 6:4).” It is therefore necessary that parents support the philosophy and teaching of the school if they are to enroll their children in its ministry.

The following admissions procedures have been adopted to assure consistent standards of admission in agreement with the philosophy and charter of Mansfield Christian School.

1. A completed application, all reference forms, school records, test scores, and application fee shall be submitted to the General Office.
2. The administration will coordinate the admissions process and interview with the parents and the applicant when necessary. After an initial interview at Mansfield Christian School, the Independent Studies supervisor will conduct an interview in the home. The administration will make all final enrollment decisions.
3. Kindergarten students must be five years old on or before September 30 of their school year and first grade students must be six years old on or before September 30 of their school year.
4. Mansfield Christian School makes no distinction concerning an individual’s race or ethnic background as we acknowledge that there is no preferential treatment with God. (Romans 2:11).
5. A letter will follow the interview to inform of approval or non-approval for enrollment
6. The following points will be considered during the interview:
  - a. Involvement with a Bible-believing church
  - b. Special needs due to academic deficiencies or learning disabilities
  - c. Parents’ and applicant’s personal relationship with Jesus Christ
  - d. Lifestyle of the family and its compatibility with the philosophy of the school
  - e. Lifestyle of the individual applicants and conduct in previous school or home school circumstance.
  - f. The purpose for applying to Mansfield Christian School
