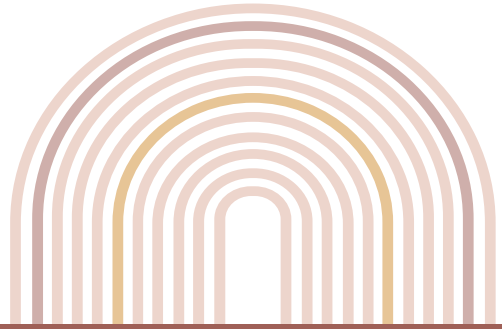

Please check red folders daily and initial student behavior logs.

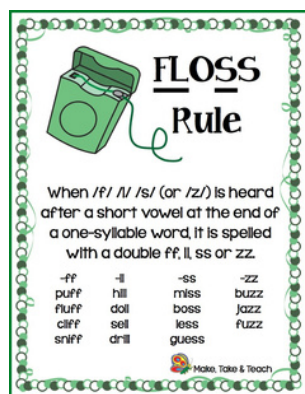
IMPORTANT INFORMATION


