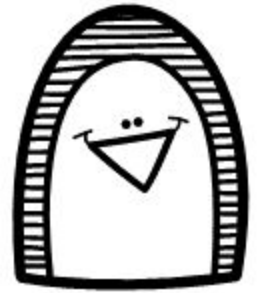


# JANUARY
