## From Student Health Services:

In prioritizing the health and well-being of our students, we remind you of the following guidelines to ensure a safe and healthy school environment.

### Stay Home if Sick:

Please keep your child at home if they are feeling unwell. This helps prevent the spread of illnesses within the school community.

### Fever Free for 24 Hours:

If your child has had a fever, they should remain at home until they have been fever-free for a minimum of 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications. This measure helps ensure their full recovery and reduces the risk of contagion.

### 24-Hour Rule after Vomiting:

Following an episode of vomiting, students should refrain from returning from school until 24 hours has passed since their last instance of vomiting. This precaution is in place to safeguard the health of all students and staff.

Additionally, please note that if a student did not attend school or was sent home from school due to an illness, they are not permitted to attend any school functions or events that day.
