Current 6th Grade Students

Before the first day of school, incoming 7th grade students should receive a new Tdap and a Meningococcal vaccination.

2024 Kindergarten Students

Before beginning Kindergarten students should have received the following vaccine dosages: 4 DTaps, 3 Polios, 2 MMRs., 3 Hepatitis B's, and 2 Varicella.
