How to take a CLEP exam

Two local universities provide CLEP examinations: Mount Vernon Nazarene and Ashland University. The student is responsible for contacting the university of their choice, scheduling an appointment and payment to the university and CLEP. Below is the information on both of these universities. The exam takes approximately 90 min. Testing times are limited at both universities. Call to make an appointment early; do not wait until the last minute. CLEP will send your score as a transcript to **one** college of your choice free; this takes approximately 4-6 weeks for them to process. Additional transcripts are \$20 to each college. You will receive your score as soon as you finish the exam. **Please notify Mrs. Pounds in the secondary office of your score.**
