



### Benefits of participation in the College Credit Plus (CCP) program

- Earning college credit for free, a tremendous cost savings
- The ability to earn a college degree while completing the requirements of high school
- College Credit Plus courses are weighted the same as your AP and IB courses
- A large selection of courses and areas of study not normally available to high school students
- 15 and 30 hour pathways for various career fields to comply with the College Credit Plus requirements for high schools

### How to Apply

NORTH CENTRAL STATE COLLEGE WILL REQUIRE THAT ALL APPLICATION MATERIALS (INCLUDING APPROPRIATE TEST SCORES) BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN 30 DAYS BEFORE THE SEMESTER BEGINS.

- Attend your school district's CCP Information Meeting. Contact your district for details.
- Complete the College Credit Plus application to North Central State College
- Submit a high school transcript or middle school report card.
- Demonstrate qualifying test scores: Submission of the Reading score is required. Math and English scores may be required depending on individual course selection. Qualifying scores: ACT Reading (21), Math (21-28) depending on individual course selection, English (18) for English Composition I. The college's Compass or ACCUPLACER test can also qualify. - Submit a completed CCP Authorization & Advising form (requires signature of guidance counselor, student, and parent). Once accepted you will receive a letter of acceptance and registration instructions.
- A **MANDATORY ORIENTATION** will be held for all new students taking courses at a NCSC campus or online.

### Important Deadlines

**April 1:** (State Deadline) By April 1, notify your school counselor of your intent to participate in College Credit Plus in 2016-17. After April 1, you will need permission from the school district superintendent to participate. \*Private School or Home School students, visit <https://ohiohighered.org/ccp> to obtain instructions, deadlines and funding applications.

**May 1:** NCSC Priority Deadline for Summer & Fall 2016 enrollment. Have all enrollment materials submitted to NCSC.
