Offerings

Elementary

Kindergarten through 6th grade students meet two Fridays each month for art, music, physical education, science and chapel. Classes also include preparation for the Christmas Musical, Grandparents Day, Christmas and Valentine's Day parties, Speech Meet and other academic opportunities.

Students will enjoy learning and participating in academic classes while interacting with other children.

Secondary

7th - 12th grade students can enroll in up to three classes at Mansfield Christian School during the regular school day and complete their other subjects at home.

High School students, upon completing the requirements, may take College Credit Plus courses to earn college credit.

Weekly Classes

5th - 12 grade students can enroll in weekly English and/or Science class.

These classes are taught by godly, experienced teachers. They prepare 5th-8th grade students for high school classes. High school students earn one graduation credit for each weekly class.
