Every IS family has a licensed educator with whom they meet each month. This teacher helps to coordinate their family's education plan, choose and implement curriculum, provide support, encouragement and important academic resources.

Once enrolled in IS, students have the same rights and privileges offered to all other students in the building. IS students have access to school libraries, a resource room full of curriculum choices, hands on learning tools, manipulatives and science materials for families to use at home. Students also participate in monthly field trips, STEM and robotics courses, sports and clubs, choir and band, end of year testing, and many fellowship and community building opportunities for parents.

The support offered by MCS through Independent Studies is second to none. MCS provides an academic home and a safe place for students to be challenged from a Biblical perspective. Being a part of MCS from a young age provides students with an easy transition option when ready for more advanced, college level courses, or fine arts and core courses during junior high and high school years.



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
